CoRE 2010: Solutions Delivery and the Transformation of the Service Provider Industry How is the Role of the Service Provider Changing?

The focus of this program is the evolving practice of outsourcing and role of external resources in enabling the core work of the corporation. Corporate solutions and service delivery will be examined from three perspectives:

* Solutions based on the integration of a service delivery network that includes the corporate end user, the internal corporate support groups and external providers;

* Changes in the real estate service provider industry, including distinctions between solution providers and service providers, and

* Integration across the different external provider industries (IT, HR, CRE, etc.) supporting corporate solutions delivery.

Examples of innovative practices by Procter & Gamble will be noted.

Directions to Union League :

From North of Philadelphia in Pennsylvania - Follow I-95 South to Exit 22. Take 676 West/Central Philadelphia Exit. Follow 676 West to the first exit, which is Broad Street/Central Philadelphia. This exit will bring you onto 15th Street. Continue on 15th Street until you see City Hall on your left. Bear left around City Hall. Make a right at the first light, which is Broad Street. Take Broad Street two blocks to Sansom Street. Make a right onto Sansom. The Midtown Parking Garage is on the right. The entrance to the Union League is directly across the street on the left. Look for the awning. This entrance should be used for The Inn at the League.

From South of Philadelphia (Philadelphia International Airport) in Pennsylvania - Follow I-95 North to Exit 22. Follow signs for 676 West/Central Philadelphia Exit. Exit to the left. Follow 676 West to the first exit which is Broad Street/Central Philadelphia. This exit will bring you onto 15th Street. Continue on 15th Street until you see City Hall on your left. Bear left around City Hall. Make a right at the first light, which is Broad Street. Take Broad Street two blocks to Sansom Street. Make a right onto Sansom. The Midtown Parking Garage is on the right. The entrance to the Union League is directly across the street on the left. Look for the awning. This entrance should be used for The Inn at the League.

From East of Philadelphia in New Jersey - Benjamin Franklin Bridge to 676 West/Central Philadelphia Exit. Get on 676 West, then take the first exit, which is Broad Street/Central Philadelphia. This exit will bring you onto 15th Street. Continue on 15th Street until you see City Hall on your left. Bear left around City Hall. Make a right at the first light, which is Broad Street. Take Broad Street two blocks to Sansom Street. Make a right onto Sansom. The Midtown Parking Garage is on the right. The entrance to the Union League is directly across the street on the left. Look for the awning. This entrance should be used for The Inn at the League.

From West of Philadelphia in Pennsylvania - Take the PA Turnpike to Exit 326, which is the Valley Forge Exit. When you exit, take 76 East to Exit 344, which is 676 East/Central Philadelphia Exit. Take the second exit, which is Broad Street/Central Philadelphia. Stay in the right hand lane as you exit. Make a right at the light, which is 15th Street. Continue on 15th Street until you see City Hall on your left. Bear left around City Hall. Make a right at the first light, which is Broad Street. Take Broad Street two blocks to Sansom Street. Make a right onto Sansom. The Midtown Parking Garage is on the right. The entrance to the Union League is directly across the street on the left. Look for the awning. This entrance should be used for The Inn at the League.

From New Jersey Turnpike - Take Turnpike to Exit 4. Take NJ Route 73 North, follow onto NJ-90 West which becomes Betsy Ross Bridge. Exit bridge onto I-95 South to I-676 West to Central Philadelphia, and follow directions from East of Philadelphia in Pennsylvania.
