NEW ACCELERATED UNDERGRADUATE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DEGREE ANNOUNCED

Rosemont, PA-Rosemont College's Schools of Graduate and Professional Studies announces its newest program, a bachelor of science in Criminal Justice. The College will begin admitting students into the program for the fall 2007 semester.

The new degree is designed to prepare students to step into leadership roles in fields of law enforcement, the judicial system, and corrections. The program will emphasize critical analysis of history of the criminal justice system, current trends in law enforcement and corrections, and an in depth study of the societal influences on criminal behavior.

"Rosemont College is committed to enhancing opportunities for adult learners," said Mary Sortino, Psy.D., Dean of the School of Graduate and Professional Studies. "The criminal justice program has been developed with top ranking area law enforcement officials. This program will meet the educational needs of students of varied interest and will teach students how to evaluate statistical data and apply it appropriately to develop solutions to real world issues in the rapidly changing field of criminal justice."

Dr. Sortino continued, "Upon completion of the 48-credit hour major, students will be prepared for careers in law enforcement, corrections, court administration, private security as well as graduate study and law school."

Rosemont College Schools of Graduate and Professional Studies will host an Accelerated Undergraduate Information Session from 5:45 to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, August 7 in Rosemont College's Main Building.
