Campus Relocates to Franklin Mills Complex

The CHI Institute Southampton campus relocated to a larger facility in the Franklin Mills complex on Oct. 22, making it Philadelphia's newest career-focused, post-secondary campus. Located at 125 Franklin Mills Blvd., Philadelphia, the campus is approximately 15 miles northeast of City Center, Philadelphia. The campus serves approximately 700 students, mostly from the greater Philadelphia metropolitan area.

The campus' new home was completely renovated and designed to provide an optimal learning environment to new and existing students. The 50,000-square-foot facility consists of two buildings: the student center and the admissions and financial aid building. The student center boasts a large atrium spanning the length of the building with a 25-foot-tall ceiling.

The new facility also provides students with a larger library, additional classrooms, a spacious cafeteria, an outdoor patio, increased parking, added security and increased access for students and employees via numerous public transportation routes.

"We brought with us everything from our Southampton location that makes this school successful—our dedicated faculty, our caring staff and most importantly, our student body. The school will host a ribbon cutting ceremony on Thursday, Nov. 8, from 2 to 4 p.m. at the campus. The ceremony will begin with remarks followed by a reception and student-guided tours of the new campus. Guests will include Kaplan Higher Education executives, local constituents, students, staff and faculty. All Chamber members are invited to attend.

CHI Institute – Franklin Mills offers three associate degrees and five diplomas in programs including criminal justice, network engineering technology, respiratory therapy, electrician, computer networking, medical office administration, pharmacy technician and medical assistant with phlebotomy. The school is committed to providing the greater Philadelphia area with trained professionals in some of the most in-demand fields in the state.
