PFCU Bake Sale Benefits Local Domestic Violence Program

Philadelphia, PA, December 23, 2008 –Philadelphia Federal Credit Union is giving back this holiday season by hosting two Holiday Bake Sale events and donating the proceeds to Women Against Abuse (WAA).

Employees of PFCU baked items for the events and were able to raise over \$370 in just two days for Sojourner House, WAA’s transitional housing program. Aside from bake sale proceeds, PFCU’s Board of Directors was happy to match the donation, for a total of over \$740.

“We were thrilled with the tremendous response that we received from our employees,” said PFCU Executive Vice President Katherine Robinson. “It’s such a great cause and we’re glad to be able to show our support, especially during the holidays.”

Women Against Abuse (WAA) is the only comprehensive program in Philadelphia whose sole purpose is to assist victims of domestic violence and their children. The Sojourner House provides longer-term housing and supportive services to domestic violence victims, such as group counseling, after-school programs and economic management education.

Philadelphia Federal Credit Union was founded in 1951 and is currently among the top credit unions in the city, serving the entire Philadelphia and Bloomsburg, PA communities, in addition to the owners, employees and directors of over 600 organizations throughout Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delaware.
