PHILADELPHIA, PA— Since early colonial days, the search for truth has been one of our Nation's greatest pursuits and one of the many reasons why we are proud to call ourselves Americans. In the birthplace of our nation, one proud citizen has recently demonstrated his patriotism and dedication to the search for truth on a national level.

On Thursday, August 6, 2009, Philadelphia native and polygraph instructor, Nathan J. Gordon was sworn in as President-Elect of the American Polygraph Association at their 44th Annual Conference, in Nashville, Tennessee. He will serve as the president of the organization in 2010.

Mr. Gordon has lectured on polygraph and forensic interviewing, having taught courses in Singapore, South Africa, Switzerland, Israel, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Mexico and throughout the United States for prominent groups including the Federal Bureau of Investigation, United States Secret Service, Central Intelligence Agency, and the Staff at Camp David. He is the innovator of the Forensic Assessment Interview Technique, Integrated Interrogation Technique, Integrated Zone Comparison Polygraph Technique, Horizontal Scoring System for analysis of polygraph data and the ASIT PolySuite Algorithm for manually driven computerized scoring of polygraph data. He also co-authored *Effective Interviewing and Interrogation Techniques*, (Academic Press, 2002), now in its 2nd Edition.

In addition to his service with the American Polygraph Association, Mr. Gordon is president of Keystone Intelligence Network Inc., a full service private investigative firm in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and Director of the Academy for Scientific Investigative Training, an accredited school that teaches the art of polygraph and forensic interviewing to students from around the world. A native South Philadelphian, who currently resides in Northeast Philadelphia, he is a graduate of Temple University (B.A. Psychology) and the University of South Africa (M.A. Criminology).
