PFCU Reopens West Philadelphia Branch

Philadelphia, PA, May 28, 2010 – Philadelphia Federal Credit Union’s Board of Directors, Senior Management team and employees gathered to officially cut the ribbon for the new West Philadelphia branch on May 10.

The branch, located at 5000 Baltimore Avenue, was built in the same location as the previous building. It features six teller stations, seven platform desks and also includes a greeter station, self-service coin machine, internet café area and express services. Outside of the building, a walk-up 24-hour ATM is available.

PFCU is pursuing LEED certification and looks to attain Basic Certification due to its sustainable efforts in the categories of: Water Efficiency, Recycled Content, Regional Materials, Indoor Air Quality and Optimized Energy Performance.

PFCU was founded in 1951 and is currently among the top credit unions in the city, serving the entire Philadelphia and Bloomsburg, PA communities, in addition to the owners, employees and directors of over 400 organizations throughout Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delaware.
